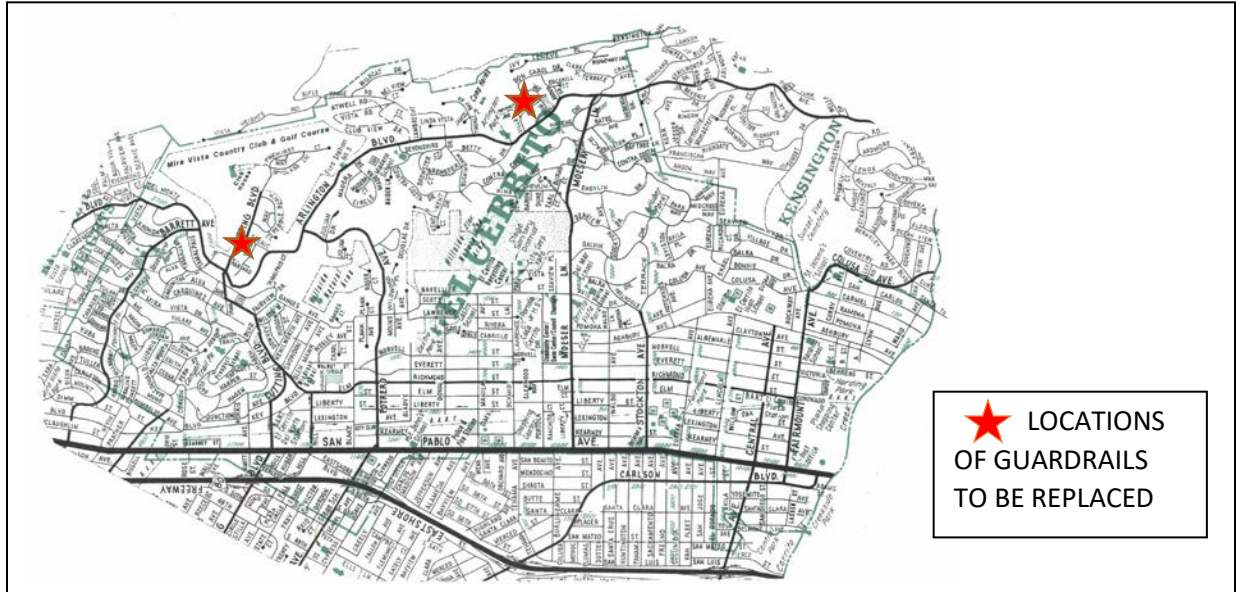


The City of El Cerrito is inviting informal bids for the Arlington Blvd. Guardrail replacement Project, Contract C 3081. This project will rehabilitate the existing guardrails in two locations on Arlington Blvd and across the street at the following addresses: 2212 Arlington and 1086 Arlington. See attached map below.



In general, the informal bid will require the awarded contractor to acquire a non-fee encroachment permit with the City, attend a pre-construction meeting and weekly meetings with City staff, provide mobilization, traffic control (submittal of engineering stamped traffic control plan and implementation of traffic control maintaining one lane open at all time during construction), submittal of the stormwater control plan and material submittals, protection of existing improvements and trees, construction of temporary signage; clear and grubbing, removal and proper disposal of the existing damaged guardrails, installation of new Midwest guardrail, and new traffic signs.
